# DRESS REHEARSAL

# Dress Rehearsal Friday, June 24th

Location: Lehigh Valley Charter High School for the Arts 321 E 3rd St, Bethlehem, Pa 18015

\*Everyone will enter the school from the Columbia St Entrance (back of building)

#### Time:

- **4:30pm** All Tiny Movers classes should arrive at 4:30pm and can leave after the Finale rehearsal
- 4:45pm- Everyone else should be ready to go by 5pm and can leave after their last number

#### Where should we go when we arrive?

- Once you arrive for dress rehearsal, please enter the school throught the Columbia St Entrance.
- One of our instructors will be there to guide you to your dancer's designated 'dressing room'
- Once your dancer is in the costume for their first number, they can sit in the theatre!

#### Who should come to dress rehearsal:

- Dress rehearsal is mandatory for all dancers performing in the recital
- Dancers should bring only one adult with them to dress rehearsal

#### Do dancers need their costume?

- If a dancer is only in one routine, they should come to dress rehearsal in costume, with hair and makeup done, and bring the proper dance shoes in their dance bag. Dancers can leave after they run through their dance onstage.
- If a dancer is in multiple dances, they should come wearing their nude leotard and tights as a base with comfy warm up clothes over top, hair and makeup exactly how they will wear it for the show. They should bring ALL costumes and shoes. (Please make sure your belongings are labeled!!) Dancers can leave after they run their last dance onstage.



#### WHAT IS DRESS REHEARSAL?

Dress rehearsal is an opportunity for dancers to practice their routine onstage, in their costumes, tights, hair and makeup. This is especially helpful for first time performers and for dancers who are in multiple numbers & need to practice any quick changes! Dress rehearsal is basically a 'practice run' of the show!

# DAY OF THE SHOW

# Lights, Camera, Action! June 25th & 26th

# Location: Lehigh Valley Charter High School for the Arts 321 E 3rd St, Bethlehem, Pa 18015

#### Time:

- All dancers should arrive to the theatre 45mins before the start of the show (do not be late, the show will start whether you are there or not)
- Doors for the audience will open 15mins before the start of the show
- Each show will begin promptly at the designated start time
- We expect each show to be approximately 1.5hrs long

#### Where do we go when we arrive?

- When dropping off your dancer, please enter through the Columbia St entrance and visit the Check-In Table. We ask that dancers please be dropped off by ONE adult, the same adult that will be picking them up.
- For all dancers 13yrs & under, you will receive a wristband at drop off with your dancer(s) name. That same adult must return to the backstage area at the end of the show to pick up your dancer. No dancer will be dismissed to anyone who does not have a wristband with that dancer's name on it.
- Once you have dropped of your dancer and they are all set in the dressing area, adults must exit through the Columbia St exit and walk around to the front entrance on 3rd st to enter the theatre.
- · No adults will be allowed to enter/exit the theatre from the Columbia St entrance

#### Where does the audience enter?

- The audience will enter the building through the 3rd St Entrance.
- Theatre doors will open 15mins before the show begins.

#### Where do dancers stay during the show?

- Most dancers will be in the cafeteria during the show.Each class will have a designated area. We will have pop up dressing rooms for dancers who would like more privacy while changing, however we encourage all female dancers who have costume changes to wear a nude leotard for modesty while changing.
- Male dancers will have a seperate 'dressing area' in the hallway near the stage doors
- Valley Dance Company dancers will be in the Green Room/Backstage area

#### Who will be watching the dancers backstage?

- Miss Mari, Miss Julia & Miss Becka will be backstage to help dancers with quick changes and to make sure dancers are lined up and ready to perform.
- We will also be looking for adults to be Backstage Helpers

#### What is a Backstage Helper?

- A Backstage Helper is responsible for making sure everyone is well behaved backstage & being respectful to the Charter Arts property,
- Backstage helpers will also assist dancers with any quick changes and whatever else they may need.
- Being a backstage helper is a GREAT experience for both you and your dancer! You get to be 'behind the scenes' and see the show from a different perspective!

#### Who can be a Backstage Helper?

- We would like 1-2 adults from each of our 9 & under classes to help backstage. (*Tiny Movers will not need a Backstage Helper as they will sit in the audience after they perform*)
- All other adults who would like to sign up as Backstage Helpers are more than welcome to! Since most of our students will be in the cafeteria, you will be helping with everyone (not just one designated class)
- Due to the fact that a majority of our dancers are female, we do ask for only female Backstage Helpers (we thank you for understanding)

#### Will Backstage Helpers be able to watch their dancer's perform?

- YES! When your child is onstage, we welcome Backstage Helpers to quietly come backstage into the wings to watch their dancer perform.
- This is a super fun opportunity and you can snap some great pictures from the wings (just no flash please!)

#### Do Backstage Helpers need a ticket?

• Nope! If you are volunteering to be a Backstage Helper you do not need to purchase a ticket for the show since you will not be sitting in the theatre

#### What is the Finale?

- The finale is the last moment in the show where all dancers will come onstage to take their final bow and dance along to a fun song.
- Dancers should wear the last costume they were wearing in the show.
- If dancers have a Recital T-Shirt they can put it on over their costume or wear it with black leggings or black dance shorts.

#### How do we pickup our dancers after the show?

- To avoid chaos backstage, we ask that only the adult with the wristband come backstage to pick up each dancer (please do not bring any siblings or other adults).
- The backstage area will be very crowded after the show and we want to ensure everyone leaves with the correct person.
- Our instructors will be stationed at each dressing room entrance to help with dismissal
- Please be sure to have your wristband on!

# WHAT TO BRING TO THE RECITAL

- Costumes
- Mask(s)
- Tights
- Nude leotard (for dancers in multiple numbers)
- Shoes
- Hair Ties
- Bobby Pins
- Hairspray
- Comb/Brush
- Makeup
- Water (No colored juices or food while in costume)
- Put your dancers name on EVERYTHING!!
- Bring a laundry basket, big box or big bag to throw costumes/shoes/accessories in while changing
- A blanket to sit on backstage
- Something to keep them occupied backstage if they are only in a few numbers (coloring pages, small toys, etc...)

#### Pre-sale for our 2022 Dance Recital will begin May 18th at 11:30am!

#### What is Pre-Sale?

During pre-sale, families will receive a code to purchase 4 tickets per family max per show. (for example, if you have 2 children who dance, your family will only receive ONE pre-sale code).

#### Why is there a limit?

To ensure that all families can purchase tickets to their dancers' show, we must limit the number of tickets everyone can initially purchase.

#### How do we purchase tickets during the pre-sale?

Before the pre-sale begins, all families will receive a special code via email. This code will enable each family to purchase 4 tickets per show.

#### **Ticket Prices**

Tickets will be \$15-\$18. Most seats will be \$18/ticket. The side balcony seats will be \$15 since they require you to turn your head to view the stage

#### What happens if I have an overdue balance in my Parent Portal account?

Unfortunately, the pre-sale code will not be available to families who have an overdue balance in their Parent Portal account. To ensure that you receive your pre-sale code, please pay your overdue balance as soon as possible!

#### When can we purchase more tickets?

Pre-Sale will be open for one week. On May 25th at 11:30am, as long as tickets are still available, we will open up ticket sales to the general public. At that time you can purchase as many tickets as you would like!

#### Are seats assigned?

Yes! All seats within the theatre will be assigned. Meaning, when you purchase tickets, you will be able to choose which seats you would like!

# TICKET SALES

#### Will tickets be available at the door?

We do expect all three shows to sell out during online sales. However, if there are available tickets come showtime, we will sell them at the door!

#### Are there any Covid Precautions for the audience?

As of right now masks are optional and there will be no social distancing amongst the seats. We are opening ticket sales only one month before the show to allow us to make updates if we need to change things due to Covid. If that occurs, we ask for everyone's understanding as we will only be following the venue's guidelines.
