During portrait day(s) we photograph multiple poses for each dancer in their costume. Then we post the images on line so you can order exactly what you want.

**\*\*Students must walk into the studio camera ready for their session time\*\***

***Consider buying digital files!*** You can print from the high-resolution and original digital files. The low-resolution files are great for social media, email, your cell phone and many other things. They are sent to you immediately after you pay for them!

***The \$5.00 Low Resolution*** digital files are not intended to print from - best for social media.

***The \$10.00 High Resolution*** digital files can be used for social media but it will also print up to an 8x10 inch print. It is also very nice for screen saver slide shows or desktop backgrounds.

***The \$25.00 Original*** digital file is the large file that the professional camera produced. This is the highest quality you can get and is great if you want to print anything above an 8x10. Some people buy this simply to archive the best quality image they can.

**When ordering prints you control the exact crop of your images.** With our web site you are working directly with the lab software. You also have a choice of either glossy (shiny) or luster (matte finish) photo finishes and several photo sizes including square formats.

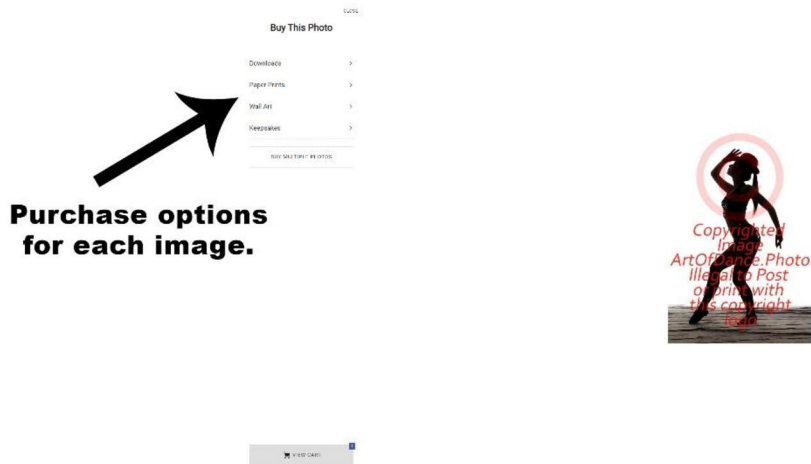
**If orders are not placed before September 30<sup>th</sup> there will be a \$20.00 per gallery reposting fee.**

# Read this before you order

1. When you click on the portrait session or recital number that you want to view all of the photos are displayed on one page. All you need to do is scroll down. Click on a thumbnail to see a larger version. When you move your cursor over the photos you will see the file numbers appear.

2. When you find images you want to order simply click on the photo you want to order. A larger version of the image will appear. If you like the photo simply click on the “Buy” Icon. When you click on “Buy” you will then click on “This Photo”. The next screen to appear is shown below:



The tabs next to the photo will give you purchase options for digital downloads, canvas prints, photo novelties and standard prints. If you are buying multiple photos of different images all you need to do is click on the quantity you want then click “Close”. Your cart will automatically be updated.

3. You control your own cropping! When you decide to order prints, it is up to you to crop the image the way you want it. If you do not crop the image it will not be cropped when you receive it. When you are checking out make sure to crop each image so it arrives the way you want it. See below:



4. Remember you are dealing directly with the professional lab. If you need help with ordering or you have questions about your order DO NOT click on contact at the bottom of the site. That sends you to the photographers email and we cannot help because we do not control the orders. You must contact the lab if you have questions on your order or how to order.
